The Port of Melbourne is an international gateway to export markets, with more than 21 direct shipping services every week connecting Australian products to key export markets in Asia, North America and Europe.

Around 100,000 tonnes of fresh and frozen vegetables are exported each year from the Port to major destinations including Belgium, Japan and Korea.

This behind the scenes tour of the Melbourne Port facility, free for levy payers, will provide growers with an interest in accessing exports to learn more about the facilities by seeing first-hand the role of the Melbourne Port facility in the export supply chain.
